



THE UPPER TERRACE AND LOWER GARDEN ARE LINKED BY BROAD STEPS FLANKED BY PLANTED BEDS SET AT AN INTERMEDIATE LEVEL
A LEAN-TO TIMBER SHED IN 'ABERDENSHIRE LAP' PROVIDES STORAGE NEAR THE HOUSE

CONTEMPORARY SLATTED TRELLIS MOUNTED OVER THE LOWER BOUNDARY WALL ENHANCES PRIVACY
THE MAIN PATH WILL BE LIT AND THE MAIN DECORATIVE FEATURES WILL BE SPOT-LIT

A GENEROUSLY PROPORTIONED PATH WINDS THROUGH THE GARDEN TO THE DECK WHICH PROVIDES A SITTING AREA OUTSIDE THE RELOCATED SUMMERHOUSE
SUBSTANTIAL MIXED PLANTING SOFTENS THE CENTRAL AREAS OF THE GARDEN

OPEN-CANOPIED BIRCHES PROVIDE VERTICAL ACCENTS WHILST A SMALL MULTI-STEMMED BIRCH PROVIDES PARTIAL SCREENING OF THE ADJOINING BUILDING
